

**CITY OF FAIRVIEW HEIGHTS
CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
SEPTEMBER 4, 2018**

The regular meeting of the Fairview Heights City Council was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Mayor Mark Kupsky in the Municipal Complex, 10025 Bunkum Road, Fairview Heights, IL with the Pledge of Allegiance and Invocation by Deputy Clerk Cathy Bryant.

ROLL CALL

Roll call of Aldermen present: Pat Peck, Ryan Vickers, Bill Poletti, Denise Williams, Frank Menn, Joshua Frawley, Pat Baeske, Brenda Wagner and Harry Zimmerman. Alderman Roger Lowry was absent. Mayor Mark Kupsky, Deputy Clerk Cathy Bryant and Attorney Jim Gehrs were also present.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Jessica Motsinger – commented on the Freedom of Information Requests which she submitted to the Police Department and also stated that she believes in government transparency and integrity.

CONSENT AGENDA

Alderman Baeske moved to approve the August 21, 2018 City Council Minutes and the Finance Director's Report. Seconded by Alderman Wagner. Motion passed on a voice vote.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Mayor Kupsky announced the Operations Committee will meet September 5, 7:00 P.M.

COMMUNICATIONS FROM THE MAYOR

Mayor Kupsky thanked the volunteers and staff who helped make the Art Fair a successful event; Mayor stated 94 children attended the Fishing Rodeo and thanked the Parks Department, Elks Club and the IBAA for hosting a great event; Mayor stated the Wing Fest was also held this weekend.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

NEW BUSINESS

Proposed Ordinance No. 17-'18, an Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 190, "The Revised Code," Chapter 14, the Development Code, Section 14-1-11 Rules and Definitions and Article IV Supplementary Land Use and Area Bulk Regulations by adding Video Gaming Establishments. Motion made by Alderman Baeske. Seconded by Alderman Poletti. Proposed Ordinance No. 17-'18 was read for the first time.

Alderman Poletti moved to send Proposed Ordinance No. 17-'18 back to Committee to realign with the State distance. Seconded by Alderman Wagner.

Alderman Poletti withdrew the motion. Alderman Wagner withdrew the second.

Alderman Poletti moved to amend under Section 2. Video Gaming Establishments, the third paragraph by changing 2,000 feet to 500 feet. Seconded by Alderman Wagner.

Roll call on the motion to amend showed Aldermen Peck, Poletti, Williams, Menn, Wagner and Zimmerman voting "Yea." Alderman Baeske voting "Nay." Alderman Vickers voicing "Present." Alderman Frawley "Abstained." Mayor Kupsky voting "Yea." Alderman Lowry was absent. Motion passed on 7 yeas, 1 nay, 1 present, 1 abstain and 1 absent.

Proposed Resolution No. 39-'18, a Resolution approving a Special Use Permit for Rachael Coleman, to allow a Development within "B-3" Community Business District zoned property for a Bar/Tavern (Video Gaming) Establishment located at 5325 North Illinois. Motion made by Alderman Wagner. Seconded by Alderman Peck.

Roll call on Proposed Resolution No. 39-'18 showed Aldermen Peck, Vickers, Poletti, Williams, Menn, Baeske, Wagner and Zimmerman voting "Yea." Alderman Frawley "Abstained." Alderman Lowry was absent. Proposed Resolution No. 39-'18 passed on 8 yeas, 1 abstain and 1 absent.

Proposed Resolution No. 39-'18 now becomes **RESOLUTION NO. 4236-2018**.

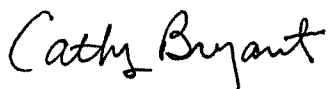

Move to approve the Holy Trinity 5k/10k Run on September 22, 2018, from 11:30 A.M. to 2:00 P.M. and to approve the closing of one lane of Fountains Parkway and to hire two Officers on overtime to redirect traffic. Motion made by Alderman Poletti. Seconded by Alderman Wagner. Motion carried.

Alderman Poletti moved to adjourn. Seconded by Alderman Menn. Motion carried.
